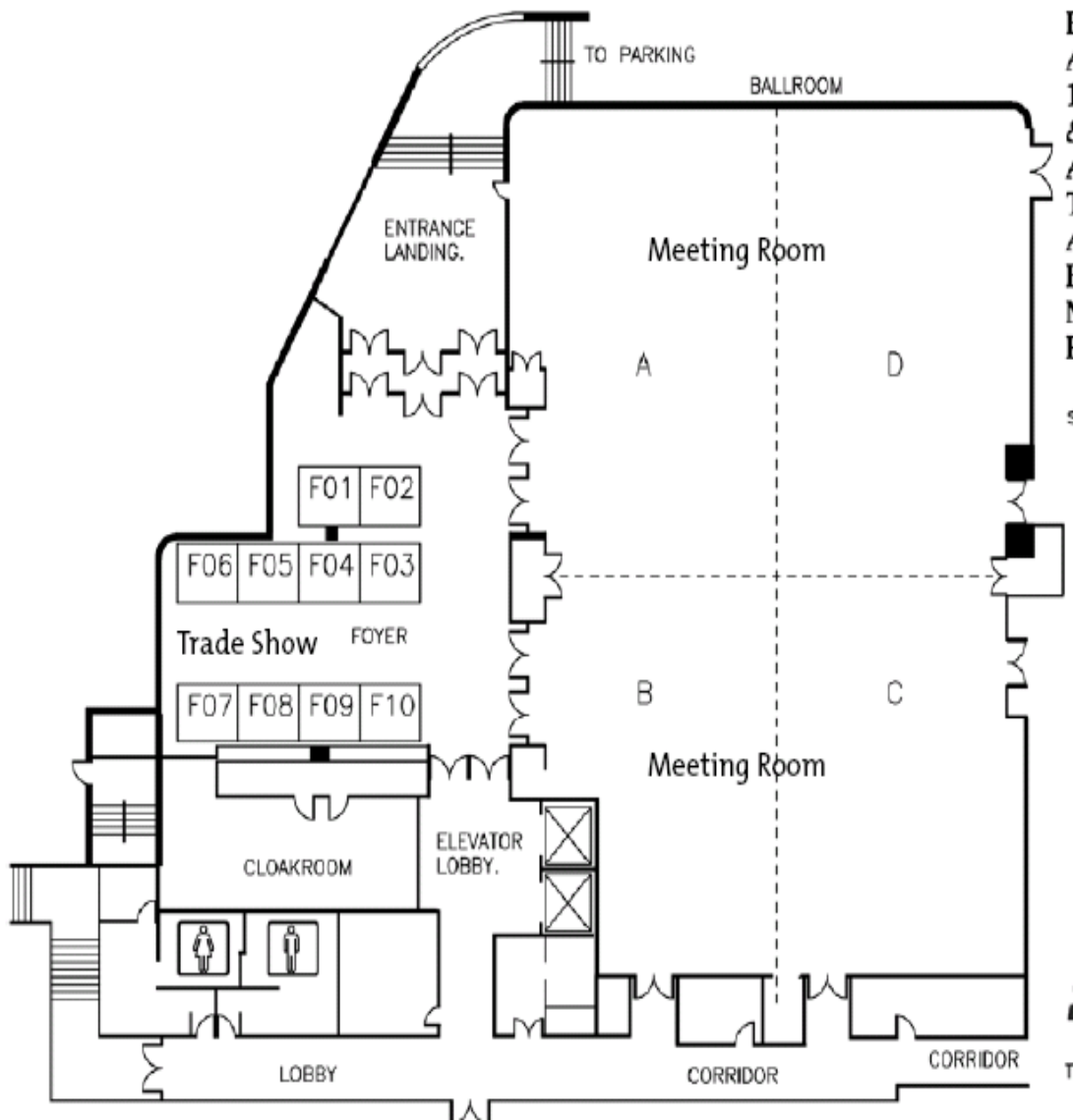

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Exhibit Space Rates in Canadian Funds

Full payment must be received when applying for exhibit space from non-I.E.Canada member companies. Member companies may request invoicing, but the association must receive payment in full for exhibit space no later than Friday, April 8, 2009. Cheques are to be made payable to the Canadian Association of Importers and Exporters. Visa, MasterCard, American Express, money orders and bank drafts are also accepted.

Goods & Services Tax (GST)

The Goods and Services Tax (GST) is a value-added tax which applies at a rate of 5% to most goods and services purchased in Canada, regardless of whether the buyer is a resident of, or a visitor to, Canada. (GST Registration No. R100766146)

Booth Space Reservation & Required Payment

Please record your preferred exhibit booth space number on the Exhibit Contract included with this package. To apply for space, you will need to submit: the completed and signed contract and full payment as outlined under “Exhibit Space Rate” of this Information Package. No booth assignment will be made until these conditions are met.

Cancellation or Reduction of Exhibit Space by I.E.Canada

I.E.Canada may cancel this contract, upon reasonable cause, or upon the happening of events beyond its control, which makes performance impossible or useless, upon written notice to the exhibitor by an authorized agent, employee, or officer of I.E.Canada. I.E.Canada reserves the right to alter, reduce, or redistribute allocated space upon reasonable cause, or upon the happenings of events beyond its control which render previous space allocation impossible or useless, upon written notice to the exhibitor by an authorized agent or employee, or officer of I.E. Canada. In the event of such cancellation or reduction, the I.E.Canada show management agrees to negotiate in good faith toward refund, reduction or alternate application of the sums paid by the exhibitor as rental fees.

Cancellation or Reduction of Exhibit Space by the Exhibitor

Cancellation or reduction of space reservations must be submitted in writing. Cancellations or reduction in space reservations received at the I.E.Canada office on or before March 27, 2009 will receive a 50% refund. No refund of payment will be made if cancellation or reduction of booth space reservation occurs after March 27, 2009. I.E.Canada will be entitled to all monies paid and owed as liquidated damages. Refunds, where applicable, shall be made without interest.

Failure to Occupy Exhibit Space

If space is not occupied by the close of the exhibit installation period, 7:30 a.m. on Monday, April 20, 2009, this will be considered a no-show and the exhibitor will forfeit the space. The forfeited space may be resold, reassigned or used by the I.E.Canada show management without obligation on the part of I.E.Canada for any refund or consultation whatsoever.

Liability and Insurance

The Exhibitor is responsible for the placement and cost of insurance relating to its participation in the show. Neither Show Management nor any of its officers, directors, employees or agents, nor the owners, employees or representatives of the exhibit facility will be responsible for any injury or damage that may occur to the exhibitor or the exhibitor's employees or property from any cause whatsoever prior, during or subsequent to the period covered by the exhibit contract. The exhibitor, on signing this contract, expressly releases the foregoing parties, individuals and firms from, and agrees to indemnify same against, any and all claims for such loss, damage or injury. Exhibitors are advised to carry insurance on their exhibits and its contents; however, this will be taken at their own expense.

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TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT BETWEEN EXHIBITOR AND I.E.CANADA, CANADIAN ASSOCIATION OF IMPORTERS AND EXPORTERS ("SHOW MANAGEMENT")

1. Show Management reserves the right to alter or change the space assigned to the Exhibitor. Show Management further reserves the right, at its sole discretion to change the date or dates upon which the show is held, or to cancel the show, and shall not be liable in damages or otherwise by reason of any such change or cancellation, other than to refund in full any amounts paid by the Exhibitor to Show Management.
2. The Exhibitor shall not assign this contract or sublet the space or any part thereof or permit same to be used by any other person, without prior written consent of Show Management. Any attempt to do so is null and void and will result in immediate cancellation of this contract, and the forfeiture of any amounts paid by the Exhibitor to Show Management.
3. The Exhibitor shall comply with all rules and regulations by Show Management for the show and agrees that Show Management's decision to adopt and enforce any such rule or regulation shall be final and binding.
4. The Exhibitor is responsible for compliance with all applicable law, bylaw, ordinances, regulations, requirements, codes and standards, including those with respect to fire, safety, health and environmental matters and shall ensure that all equipment, materials and goods used by the Exhibitor so comply.
5. The Exhibitor shall indemnify and hold Show Management harmless from and against any loss, injury or damages whatsoever suffered by Show Management as a result of the Exhibitor's failure to comply with the terms and conditions of this contract or as a result of the Exhibitors participation in the show, including without limitation, any third party claim against Show Management with respect to loss, injury or damage sustained or suffered by any other exhibitors, the owner of the building, attendees of the show, and their respective directors, officers, agents and employees.
6. Show Management may cancel this contract, upon reasonable cause, or upon the happening of events beyond its control, which makes performance impossible or useless, upon written notice to the exhibitor by an authorized agent, employee, or officer of I.E.Canada. Show Management reserves the right to alter, reduce, or redistribute allocated space upon reasonable cause, or upon the happenings of events beyond its control which render previous space allocation impossible or useless, upon written notice to the exhibitor by an authorized agent or employee, or officer of I.E.Canada. In the event of such cancellation or reduction, Show Management agrees to negotiate in good faith toward refund, reduction or alternate application of the sums paid by the exhibitor as rental fees.
7. Cancellation or reduction of space reservations must be submitted in writing. Show Management will be entitled to all monies paid and owed as liquidated damages. Refunds, where applicable, shall be made without interest.
8. Show Management reserves the right at any time to alter or remove exhibits or any part thereof, including printed material, products, signs, lights or sound, and to expel exhibitors or their personnel if, in Show Management's opinion, their conduct or presentation is objectionable to Show Management or to other show participants.
9. Exhibitor's displays must comply with all requirements of Show Management and of the owner of the building, including maximum height requirements. The Exhibitor must provide at least one staff per booth, to maintain display during show hours. The Exhibitor agrees to confine its presentation to the contracted space only.
10. All goods shipped to the show must be clearly marked with the name of the Exhibitor and the number of the display space. Goods must not be shipped to the show for any shipping charges to be paid on arrival and any such goods will not be accepted by Show Management. Show Management assumes no responsibility for loss or damage to the Exhibitors goods or property either before, during or after the show.
11. In consideration of the Exhibitor's participation in the show, the Exhibitor hereby releases Show Management, its directors, officers, agents and employees from any and all claims, losses, or damages whatsoever suffered or sustained by the Exhibitor in connection with its participation in the show, including, without limitation, any claims for loss or theft of property, personal injury, or loss of business or profits, whether arising from any act of Show Management or otherwise
12. The Exhibitor is responsible for the placement and cost of insurance relating to its participation in the show. The Exhibitor shall carry their own liability insurance.
13. The Exhibitor agrees that no display may be dismantled or goods removed during the entire run of the show. The Exhibitor agrees to remove the exhibit, equipment and appurtenances from the show building by the final move-out time. In the event of failure to do so, the Exhibitor agrees to pay for such additional costs as may be incurred by Show Management.
14. The Exhibitor will comply with the rules and regulations of any unionized contractors, which may be selected by Show Management to service the exhibitors. Any dispute between the Exhibitor and any such contractor or union representative will be referred to Show Management for resolution, whose decision shall be final and binding on all parties.
15. Show Management reserves the right to cancel this contract and to withhold possession of the space or to expel the Exhibitor there from if the Exhibitor fails to comply with any terms and conditions of this contract or the show rules and regulations, in which case the Exhibitor shall forfeit as liquidated damages and not as a penalty all payments made pursuant to this contract, all without limiting Show Management's other rights and remedies at law under this contract as a result of such failure to comply.
16. Processing of payment by Show Management does not in itself constitute acceptance into the 2009 Trade Show.
