



How to Become an ACE Participant

U.S. Customs and Border Protection Modernization

U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) invites importers, brokers, and truck carriers who want to participate in ACE to refer to three different Federal Register Notices (FRN) which describe the application process and requirements for participation. The first FRN published in May 2002 is for importers. Two more FRNs were published in February 2004 inviting brokers and truck carriers to participate. Steps to Activate your ACE Account:

1. Download the ACE Application from the Modernization & ACE web site:

2. Complete the ACE Application and return to CBP:
