Shaping Canadian Trade

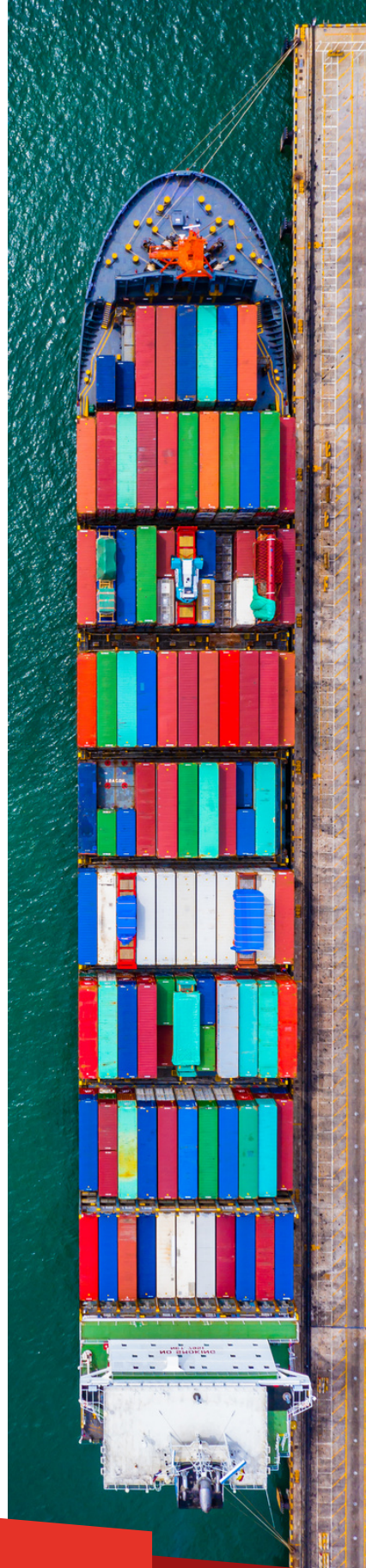
